



CLFHA Privacy Policy

What Information We Collect

The information we collect is directly from you and/or via your team representative when you register for a league program (e.g. CLFHA league, CJP league, umpiring clinics). When you send in registration details, we will ask you to provide only the information that enables us to complete your request for the program(s) that you are registering for.

Information About You

Information essential for fulfilling CLFHA program registration requirements include:

Information establishing your identity, such as your name, address, postal code, phone number, business phone number, cellular or other phone number, E-mail address, date of birth, team/club name, umpiring certification level.

Additional information may be requested to help us determine your eligibility and provide you with better information on some of the programs that we offer.

Providing us with your information is always your choice. However, in dealings involving registration and insurance, your decision to withhold particular details may limit or prevent us from completing your registration so that you are eligible to participate in various CLFHA leagues/programs. It may also make it more difficult for us to advise you or suggest appropriate alternatives.

How We Use Your Information

We use your information for the purposes communicated to you by your team reps and/or in your agreement(s) with us, for example to:

- Verify your identity;
- Register and insure you with Field Hockey Canada (FHC);
- Register you with Field Hockey Alberta (FHA);
- Register you with Calgary Ladies' Field Hockey Association (CLFHA)

We may also share it with the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (AGLC) as an aid to allow the league (CLFHA) to utilize casino funds for applicable CLFHA programs.

Additional Uses

- We may communicate with you through various channels including telephone, computer or mail using the contact information you have provided.
- If, for any reason, your information is required to fulfill a different purpose than that of your original intent, we ask for your consent before we proceed.
- Note that sensitive information will never, under any circumstances, be shared or used for a purpose other than that of the original intent.

Sharing Your Information

Access to your information is restricted to authorized league representatives, league employees, and affiliated associations who have a legitimate purpose for accessing it. Unauthorized access to and/or disclosure of personal information that is not already publicly available and without your consent is



strictly prohibited. If you choose not to have your information shared and have fulfilled registration requirements to enable you to be eligible for CLFHA programs, you will continue to be eligible to participate in the various programs. We will respect your choice and will advise other parties of your preference.

Keeping Your Information Accurate

We do the utmost to ensure the information we have about you is accurate and complete. As we make decisions based on the information we have, we encourage you to help us keep our information current.
